1. How CoughNer® Spray works

CoughNer® spray forms a protective layer on the sensitive tissue of the throat, which directly relieves a sore throat. CoughNer® spray is based on the patented 2QR-complex. This natural substance is derived from plants and consists of molecules called polysaccharides. The 2QR-complex provides a physical block to bacteria by binding itself to the receptors of the pathogenic-bacteria, preventing them from adhering to the throat mucosa. By this anti-adhesive mode of action, 2QR-complex polysaccharides support the natural healing process and thus eliminates the discomforts of inflamed tissue (sensitivity, redness, swelling and irritation).

2. How to use CoughNer® Spray

Apply at least 2 applications CoughNer® spray every 3 hours, or whenever relief is desired with a maximum of 1 bottle per day. For optimal contact time after application, do not drink or eat anything for the next 30 minutes. CoughNer® spray may be swallowed.

3. Use by children

CoughNer® spray is suitable for adults and children from three years and older. One application is approximately 0,13 ml.

4. Ingredients

One bottle contains 30ml of Coughner® Spray. Ingredients: Aqua, 2QR-complex*, Glycerin, Xylitol, Betaine, Polysorbate 20, Galactoarabinan, Dermsoft 1388, Laureth-9, Menthol, Anise Oil, Herbasesc Licorice, Rutin, Peppermint Oil.*The 2QR-complex is a patented ingredient that consists of natural polysaccharides.

5. Please note!

It is not recommended to keep using CoughNer® spray for more than 30 days consecutively. If complaints aggravate or if you develop white spots in your throat, contact your physician. Do not use the product by multiple people to avoid cross contamination. Do not use after expiry date.

Allergies to the ingredients of CoughNer® spray are very rare. When you have doubts apply on the inside of your forearm. When an itching red spot appears we advise you not to use CoughNer® spray.

Side Effects

There are no known side effects, wehn CoughNer® spray is used according to the instructions for use.

Interference with medications

There is no known negative effect between the use of CoughNer® spray and other medications.

Pregnancy and breastfeeding

There is no information available on the use of CoughNer® spray while pregnant or breastfeeding.

Storage

Store CoughNer® spray out of sight and reach of children in the original package at a temperature between 10° – 25° C. The expiry date is printed on the label of the bottle and on the bottom of the packaging.
